Crossing Matthews Range

Early morning on the 2nd day, we will be riding our safari vehicle and cross the Matthews Range. Mathews Mountain Range, (also known as Lenkiyo Hills), a range of mountains about 150km long. The place is isolated and is home to elephants and other large mammals.



Get Upclose and Personal with Elephants

By noon, you will arrive in Reteti Elephant Sanctuary. Lunch will be served. And then explore and experience the most successful community-owned elephant projects in what used to be heavily poached area.

NRT Rhino Conservancy with Samburu Warriors

Journey continues to dry lugga riverbed to Rhino Conservancy. Our guide Samburu Warriors will show us how to track a rare black rhino using their own GPS tracker.



Gem's Exploration and Camp Building

In the afternoon, exploration continues to the dry riverbed for gems deposits and then build the camp where you will spend the night under billions of African stars.

Buggies and Quad Bike Safari

A day trip into the North on buggies and quad bikes with your experienced tour guide. Drive on tiny tracks, unusable by conventional vehicles; visit ‘singing wells’, have a picnic by a remote riverbed with seasonal pools or just cover miles of country feeling like the genuine intrepid explorer



Dinner with the sound of African Night
