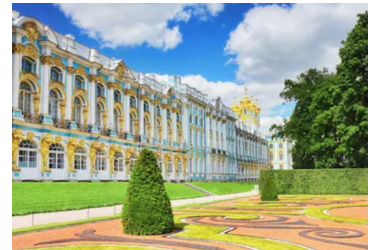


Breakfast @ the hotel

Catherine Palace & Pavlovsk Great Palace & Park Tour with Lunch

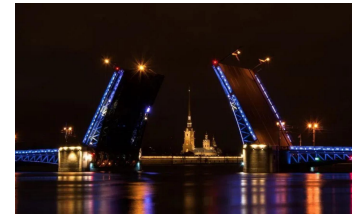

Dinner @ Sintoho, Four Seasons Hotel Lion Palace

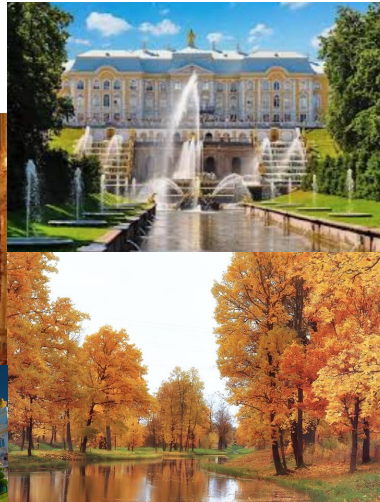
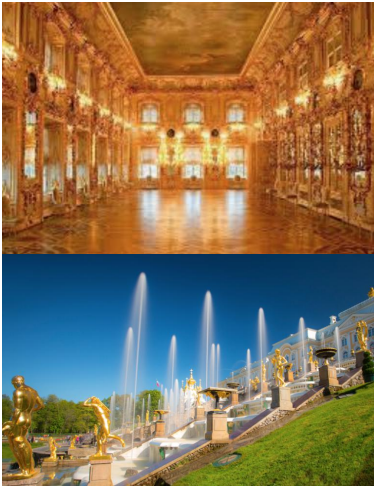
After a very very long tiring day, sample the authentic flavours of modern and lively Asian restaurant.
